VIPER AIRSHOWS

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General Information

1.1 Introduction

Several items are required by Viper Airshows (pilot and crew) while at the airshow site. The show sponsor is therefore requested to supply, (a) hotel/motel accommodations, (b) personal transportation, (c) aircraft hangar and service facilities at the airport, (d) fuel, engine oil, and smoke oil for the show aircraft.

1.2 Lodging

Accommodations to be provided for the pilot and crew. Two rooms, non-smoking. Rooms should be reserved beginning the evening prior to the first press day or first press day. Due to weather constraints, please allow the hotel/motel accommodations to be extended through the evening following the last performance. The organizer is not expected to pay any miscellaneous room charges.

1.3 Transportation

A vehicle is to be available upon arrival (if minivan or SUV is unavailable please provide two automobiles). Vehicles should be marked or have windshield passes with appropriate authority to allow access to all secured areas of the airport and the flight line at any time.

1.4 Aircraft security

Arrangements must be made to provide secure hangar space for each aircraft upon arrival. Crowd control measures must be available to protect the aircraft while in the hangar and on the flight line.

Aircraft Operational Requirements

2.1 Aircraft Fuel

Fuel must be available on the flight line for refueling between airshow flights. The performance and any support aircraft require 100/130 octane aviation fuel, or 100 octane low lead aviation fuel. Fuel requirements are:

<i>Aircraft</i>	<i>Each Performance</i>	<i>Refill After Show</i>
Pitts Viper	10 gallons	30 gallons
Beech Bonanza	N/A	50 gallons

Refueling operations are not permitted without Viper Airshows ground crew at the aircraft!!!

2.2 Aircraft Engine Oil

Engine oil must be available to replenish oil consumed during flight. Requirements for the performance aircraft are:

Type – Aero Shell W100 - 1 case per show

2.3 Aircraft Smoke Oil

Smoke oil should be available before each flight and at the conclusion of each performance day. The barrels must be portable either in the back of a pickup truck or on a hand cart.

The smoke producing characteristic of oils vary, so the correct oil must be supplied: Aeroshell, Vitrea 13, Canopus 13, Corvus Oil, Standard Oil Facto 39, Texaco Regal B, Sun Oil Circle X, Shell Carnea 10 or 22, Union Oil Unax 105, Gulf Oil 370, Arco Duro-S, 105, and Exxon Faxam 40

Smoke Oil usage:

Pitts Viper 16 gallons per flight

Miscellaneous Information

3.1 Aircraft Insurance

Viper Airshows carries public liability insurance on each aircraft for all activities including airshows in the amount of \$1,000,000.00.

3.2 Airport Service Personnel

To insure that possible mechanical problems can be remedied, a qualified aircraft mechanic (A & P), with tools, should be available during the airshow. We travel with our own mechanic, specialty tools and additional assistance may be required.

3.3 FAA Waiver Information

The following information should be used to fill out FAA form 7711-2 - Waiver Application:

- Press kits/press releases ready for distribution
- Liability insurance arranged
- Gate passes arranged
- Fuel truck reserved
- Smoke oil ordered
- Aircraft engine oil ordered
- Smoke oil truck, pump, and hose reserved
- Secure hangar space reserved

- Hotel/motel for Crew ready
- Automobiles for Crew ready
- Secure hangar ready
- Fuel, engine oil, and equipment ready
- Smoke oil and equipment ready
- Local press/TV releases received
- Local pre-show photography and TV shooting schedule confirm with
Viper Airshows.

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- () Local radio/TV appearances confirmed with Viper Airshow
- () Communication between Viper Pilot and announcer arranged
- () Vehicle and crew passes arranged
